TITLE: Positioning self with a collective identity: Japanese college students' ambivalence in an EMI classroom

ABSTRACT:

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This qualitative study explores how Japanese college students shape their identity through positioning themselves and others in English-medium instruction (EMI) classes. A semi-structured interview was individually conducted with a total of 13 first-year students enrolled in an undergraduate English-taught program at a Japanese national university. Results show that participants construct a personal identity that centers on English proficiency and active engagement. Simultaneously, such components consist of a collective identity, which function as an evaluative role in their positioning. Specifically, the findings demonstrate that a personal identity is negotiated within a collective identity: Comparing self to the collective identity, Japanese students position themselves as deficit L2 English learners and inactive participants in the classroom. Such a positional identity is then discussed from the notion of language and classroom culture, and a monolithic linguistic view of participants is problematized. Drawing a poststructuralist view, the study promotes multilingual selves and translingual spaces.
