1. Originality: Does the paper contain new and significant information adequate to justify publication?: This article is well written academically based on suitable research methodology and discussing the results and findings

accordingly to the research objectives. Very interesting study on this topic.

- 2. Relationship to Literature: Does the paper demonstrate an adequate understanding of the relevant literature in the field and cite an appropriate range of literature sources? Is any significant work ignored?: The range and depth of literature is appropriate, suitable and pertinent to this study.
- 3. Methodology: Is the paper's argument built on an appropriate base of theory, concepts, or other ideas? Has the research or equivalent intellectual work on which the paper is based been well designed? Are the methods employed appropriate?: The research method/design is not clearly described. The purpose, content, and usage of data collection tools are not explained and justified. The validity and reliability processes in data collection and analyses are not described sufficiently.

But this part needs more discussion with references to the relevant and recent literature.

1. Originality: Does the paper contain new and significant information adequate to justify publication?: The inheritance of peaceful values in society has not received much attention from conflict researchers. Peaceful inheritance functions to keep the community system running well. Maintaining peaceful conditions is as important as resolving conflicts.

However, the trend of problems that occur in the research location needs to be strengthened so that this paper can provide a broader theoretical contribution.

- 2. Relationship to Literature: Does the paper demonstrate an adequate understanding of the relevant literature in the field and cite an appropriate range of literature sources? Is any significant work ignored?: The use of literature can support the discussion in the article and is relevant to the topic of the article. But some articles are too past. For example, there is a quote from an article in 1997. Thus, the literature needs to be updated.
- 3. Methodology: Is the paper's argument built on an appropriate base of theory, concepts, or other ideas? Has the research or equivalent intellectual work on which the paper is based been well designed? Are the methods employed appropriate?: The methods (data collection, data analysis, research) used to have good accuracy and are relevant to the theory used by the author.

References referred to in the introduction section, literature review, and in other sections are well structured and relevant to the discussion.

- 4. Results: Are results presented clearly and analysed appropriately? Do the conclusions adequately tie together the other elements of the paper?: Results are presented clearly. There are findings of patterns of maintaining social harmony through local wisdom and the Social Harmony Trilogy for Social Disaster Resilience produced by the author. Including networking to maintain social harmony with various parties, is well described.
- The conclusion succeeded in binding each of the sections described in the previous sections.
- 5. Practicality and/or Research implications: Does the paper identify clearly any implications for practice and/or further research? Are these implications consistent with the findings and conclusions of the paper?: The implications are relevant to the conclusion. But some parts are out of context from the previous elements. For example, suddenly talking about society 5.0 which was not discussed in the previous sections

If indeed the author wants to link it with society 5.0, the author needs to make a theoretical bridge.

problems found in the field.

Findings in the form of local traditions are a good thing expressed by the author because they are the result of the culture of the local community. Although the findings of these traditions use the local language, the author explains the term using language that is easy to understand.

- 1. The author has not stated the broad theme or topic of the study
- 2. The author has not provided a convincing answer Why is this article important
- 3. the summary of the literature and cites the most important previous studies is limited
- 4. There are no gaps indicated that the current study address
- 2. Relationship to Literature: Does the paper demonstrate an adequate understanding of the relevant literature in the field and cite an appropriate range of literature sources? Is any significant work ignored?: This manuscript does not demonstrate a good understanding of the current literature. Besides, The literature review has not provided the reader with insights into what is known about the problem they seek to address, theoretically or practically. The literature review in this manuscript has not also provided the reader with insights into the limitations of our knowledge. The inclusion of these limitations in the literature review section will help the authors to justify why their research needs to be undertaken.
- 3. Methodology: Is the paper's argument built on an appropriate base of theory, concepts, or other ideas? Has the research or equivalent intellectual work on which the paper is based been well designed? Are the methods employed appropriate?: The authors should revise their manuscript by updating the method section. In doing so, the authors must specify the methods they used to identify, collect, and analyze their data. A reader would be left wondering what such a design might include. How was the interview implemented in the field? How were the respondents selected? How did the authors control for bias? Similarly, what exactly did the authors use as primary and secondary data? Both forms of data need to be better specified and explained. Was the primary data about community knowledge extracted from interviews or other documents?
- 4. Results: Are results presented clearly and analysed appropriately? Do the conclusions adequately tie together the other elements of the paper?: The authors should revise their manuscript so that the content of the findings (results) section is limited to just that: the reporting of the results.

The focus of the discussion section should be on how the findings presented in the manuscript contribute to the broader literature.

To this end, the authors could discuss how the findings address a gap in the literature, extend our current knowledge, or provide new insights into a specific phenomenon or problem

- 1.) Your figures should be removed. They are not neccessary. Figure 1 is not producing well and Figure 2 includes pictures of people and without their consent it should not appear. I am sensitive to these issues you need permissions.
- 2.) Please have your amendments proofed. I can see you have used a proof reader but it was not clear at all to me that the revisions have been considered. The abstract, for example, has some writing errors in it (e.g. msising words such as is). Please check your amended sections again.
