The population in this study accounting vocational school teachers account for 50 Business and Management Program in Tegal regency. Variable that is the accounting teacher performance, the leadership of school principals and discipline of work. Methods of data collection using the documentation, and questionnaires while the methods of data analysis using descriptive statistics and multiple regression.

The results showed leadership principals in very good category and discipline in the category of very good work. The leadership of school principals and discipline work simultaneously and partially affect the performance of accounting vocational school teachers in Business and Management Program in Tegal regency.

Based on research results, it can be concluded that there is influence of principal leadership and work discipline on the performance of accounting teacher, both simultaneously and partially. Suggestions that can be delivered that teachers need to improve discipline in work and willingness to keep learning themselves. The school principal needs to improve the competence of ourselves as a leader, and for the manager to formulate and education activities aimed mengiplementasikan streamline and improve managerial skills principal.
